- Do not leave any valuables and personal belongings unattended.

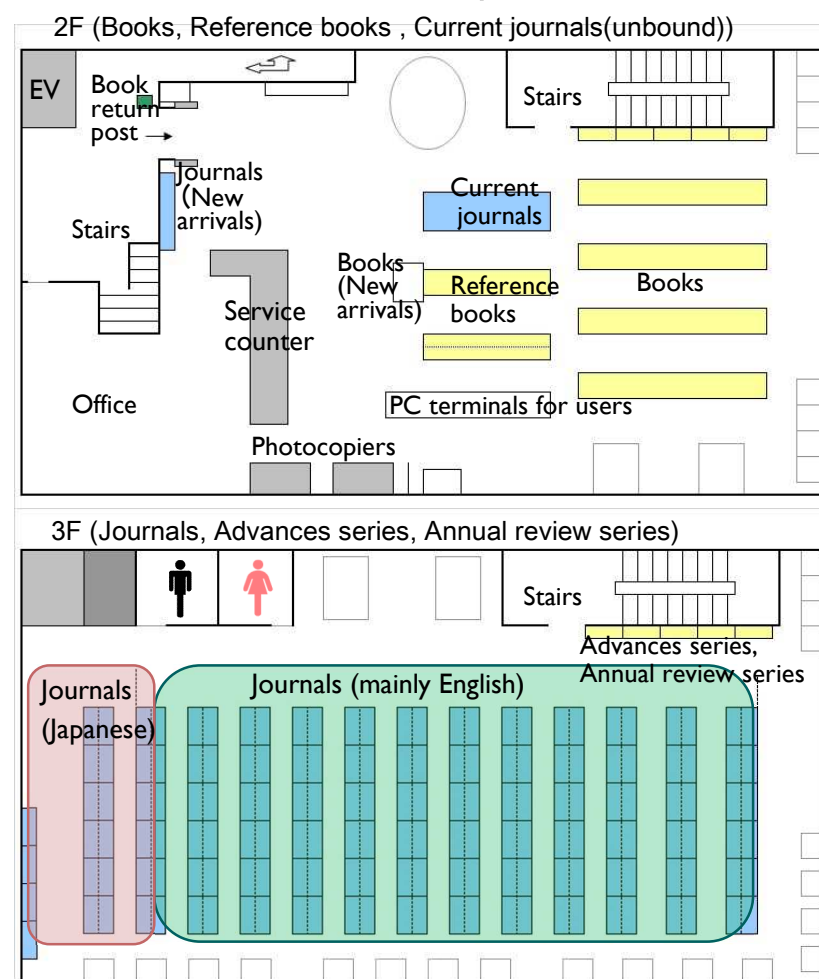

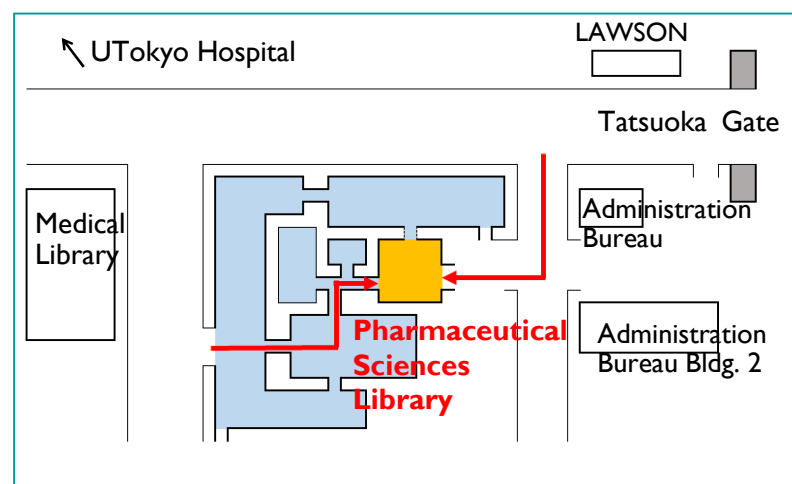

< Floor Map >

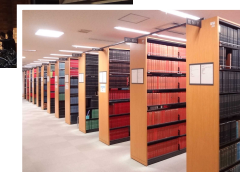


< Map around the Library >

Library Hours	Mon. - Fri. 9 : 00 - 17 : 00
Closing Days	Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays, New Year's holidays, and entrance examination periods, etc.

Borrowing (UTokyo members only)	Books	5 books, 2 weeks

Your ID card (IC card) is necessary for borrowing. If your ID card is not an IC card, you can apply for a Library IC card. Please bring your ID to the service counter. (Members of the Grad. Sch. of Pharm. Sci. or Fac. of Pharm. Sci. only)

Returning	Please bring the materials to the service counter. When the library is closed, please put the materials in the Book Post. You can return materials borrowed from the libraries in the Komaba Campus/ Kashiwa Campus/Shirokanedai Campus also.

Photocopying

You can photocopy library materials within the limits provided by the Japanese copyright law. When you copy materials, please fill in the form placed by the copy machines.

Materials in the Stack

Doctoral dissertations or materials with "4F書庫" or "5F保存書庫" stated on the "Comment" column of the OPAC search results, are stored in the closed stack. Please order them at the service counter when you wish to use them.

The materials donated by the Japanese Society for History of Pharmacy are located in the closed stack, also. They are not cataloged in OPAC, but listed on the website of the Pharmaceutical Sciences Library.

E-Resource (UTokyo members only)

Various databases ("Web of Science Core Collection", SciFinder, etc.) and many e-journals or e-books are available. Please search for e-journals or e-books using the "E-Journal Portal" and not OPAC.

Request Copies or PDF (Chargeable service)	Please order via MyOPAC. When you can not order from Hongo Campus, please visit the library holding the materials directly. *When you use the university expense at the visiting library, please obtain an "application for photocopying" at our service counter first.
Request delivery of books (Free)	Please order via MyOPAC. You can order books from Komaba Campus/Kashiwa Campus/Shirokanedai Campus.

Chargeable services require additional registration at our library in advance.

Using other University's Libraries

Sometimes letters of introduction are required when visiting another university's library. In such cases, our library will issue one. The issue of a letter of introduction will take a few days.

You can request copies or delivery of books not held in UTokyo. (Paid service) Please order via MyOPAC.

Requesting Purchase of Books

You can make a request for the library to purchase of a book which is not held in our library. Please request via MyOPAC. (Books only)

*There are cases that our library can not purchase due to budget etc.
