With the University of Tokyo OPAC, you can search for books, e-books, journals and e-journals available in the University of Tokyo.

With TREE (UTokyo Resource Explorer), you can search for printed materials and electronic copies, as well as books and articles without being aware that you are using different databases.

Please ask a librarian when you cannot find the material in the University of Tokyo.

- Do not leave any valuables and personal belongings unattended.

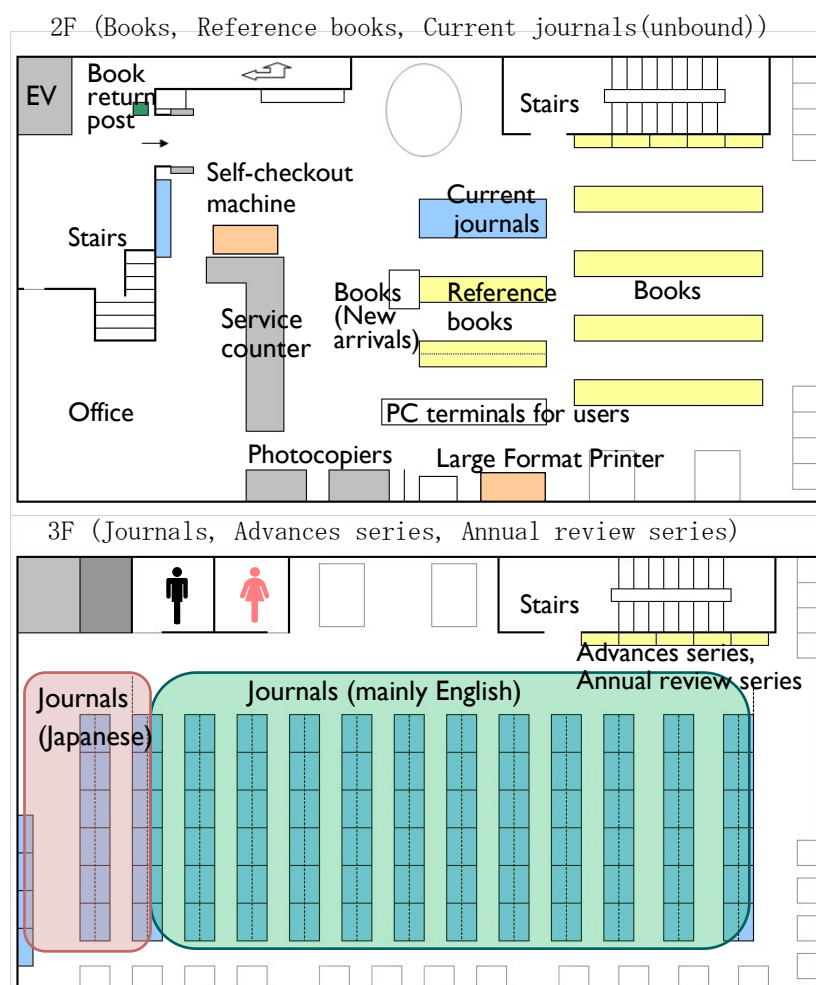

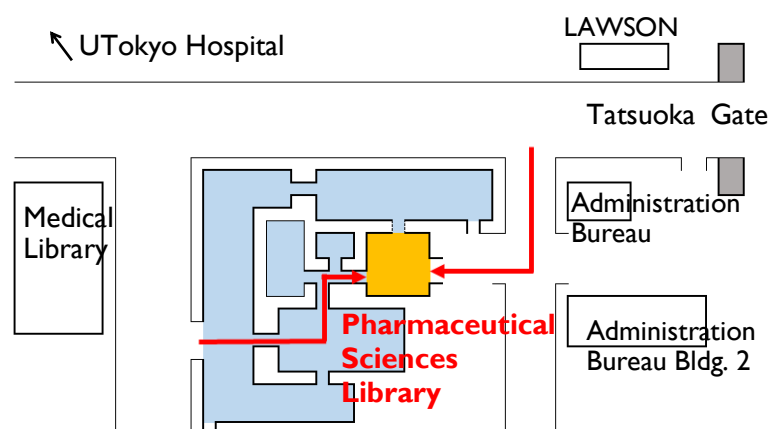
the Library website

<Floor Map>

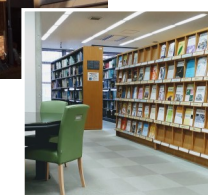


<Map around the Library>

Also, various information on e-resource is included in "Literacy" website.



"UTokyo WiFi", a campus wireless network service, is available. Members of UTokyo can connect their own PC to the internet.
